Insertion of two Course Descriptions

Course: HIT2700 Legal Aspects of Healthcare 3 Credits 45 clock hours

This course introduces the health information management profession and departmental functions related to legal aspects. It covers the basic functions, content, and structure of the healthcare record as well as paper and electronic medical record systems and management. Various aspects related to health record documentation guidelines and standards are explored as well as the influence of accreditation and regulatory bodies. Health information processes and relationships among

organizational departments and healthcare providers are also addressed. This course also emphasizes legal principles, procedures, and regulations which affect the control, use, and release of health information, including HIPAA.

Prerequisites: None

Course: HIT2800 Health Information Technology

3 Credits 45 Clock hours

This course focuses on the principles of computer technology related to health care with an emphasis on computerized medical billing and coding, health care data collection, storage, retrieval, security arrangement, presentation, and verification. This course will also introduce the students to the components and requirements of the electronic health record.
