Alumni Scholarship

The purpose of this scholarship is to help reduce the student's overall loan burden while advancing their education.

- Enroll in an eligible associated higher-level Cambridge program listed above
- Maintain continuous enrollment through program completion.
- Remain in good standing, meeting Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) requirements
- Be current on all financial obligations to Cambridge College.

Scholarship Qualification Procedure

Cambridge College of Healthcare & Technology will evaluate eligibility for the Alumni Scholarship at the conclusion of each academic term.

- Scholarship funds are awarded upon successful completion of each term
- Funds are first applied to any outstanding balance on the student's account
- If a credit balance is created, funds will be applied to the student's loan with the highest interest rate, in accordance with applicable regulations.

Applications Procedure and Deadline

Applications for the Alumni Scholarship are available through the Financial Aid Department.

- Completed applications must be submitted prior to the end of the student's first term.
- Awards are contingent upon submission of the application and meeting all eligibility requirements.
