At the completion of the program, graduates must meet the following requirements:

- Achieve a minimum cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of 2.0
- Successfully complete all required didactic, laboratory, and clinical components
- Demonstrate consistent engagement in study and skills practice throughout the program
- Complete a comprehensive practice NCLEX-PN examination with a minimum passing score of 75%

Students scoring below 75% on the practice exam must complete required remediation in identified areas prior to program completion.

Upon meeting all program requirements, graduates will be eligible to apply for the NCLEX-PN licensure examination and, upon successful completion, may seek entry-level employment as a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN).
